Hanle, is a small village in Ladakh region of the Himalayas, and has been bestowed upon with a tag 'Dark Sky Reserve'. This is a first in our country, and is due to the fact there is practically no light pollution in the region. This is the finest skies in the country and one of the finest in the world where the night sky is spectacular. And also, Hanle is home to one of the highest located telescopes in the world – The Himalayan Chandra Telescope operated by Indian Institute of Astrophysics.



- Exploring Saspol Caves (INTACH preserved caves dating back to 14th century)

 - Visit to Indian Institute of Astrophysics Facility at Hanle (MACE and Hagar Telescopes)
 - Astrophotography from Hanle and Tso Moriri Lake - Imaging the Milkyway Galaxy.
 - Visit the rare geological phenomenon 'Hot Springs' at Chumathang valley
 - Explore oldest monastery in Ladakh, palaces and other museums including Leh Market.
 - Experience a local Ladakhi festival.
